Further Revisions in Compliance with Commission Order

Dear Secretary Brillling:

On September 28, 2007, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) filed proposed tariff amendments in compliance with the Order on Capacity Release Programs (“Order”) issued on August 30, 2007 by the Public Service Commission (“Commission”). Also filed in compliance with the Commission Order, Distribution submits the following further revisions to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 8 – GAS:

Leaf No. 261	Revision 6
Leaf No. 262	Revision 8
Leaf No. 263	Revision 7
Leaf No. 264	Revision 5
Leaf No. 265.1	Revision 1
Leaf No. 265.2	Revision 1

The proposed amendments are issued as of today for an effective date of November 1, 2007. They reflect Staff’s request to increase the amount of grandfathered Supplier capacity available to the system to match the highest individual Supplier load requirement for September 2007, October 2007 or November 2007, instead of the initial proposed cutoff date of September 1, 2007. Additionally, the revisions require the Company to purchase or sell the gas associated with changes in Supplier storage capacity resulting from varying customer load requirements.

For all of the foregoing reasons, and for all the reasons stated in Distribution’s September 28, 2007 Compliance Filing, Distribution respectfully requests that the above tariff revisions be approved for an effective date of November 1, 2007 in compliance with the Order.
