Attached for electronic filing with the Commission is the following tariff leaf issued by The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a KeySpan Energy Delivery New York ("the Company") to become effective January 1, 2006:

Twelfth Revised Leaf No. 411.1  
To Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 12-GAS.

The Company proposes to require a deposit from any Energy Services Company ("ESCO") as a condition of participating in the electronic data interchange ("EDI") testing process. This deposit would reflect the Company's actual costs from the EDI service provider with respect to each ESCO. Accordingly, the purpose of the deposit is to place the ESCO at risk for testing costs, rather than the Company or its ratepayers. The deposit would be refundable in the event the ESCO becomes active on the Company's system within three months of completing EDI testing.
