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In compliance with PSC Order issued and effective August 24, 2005 in Case 05-G-0680 - Filing by RG&E to implement proration of the company's monthly Gas Supply Charge ("GSC") and to allow for the correction of the estimated cost of gas, RG&E will implement monthly proration of the Company's GSC. The GSC shall be applied to bills by prorating the gas adjustments in effect during the period of service based on the number of days each gas adjustment is in effect during each billing period. RG&E adjusted its tariff, PSC No. 16-Gas and the Company's billing system to provide for the proration of the Company's monthly GSC beginning September 1, 2005.

These rates will continue in effect until there are changes in the cost of gas that require modifications.
