These statements were originally filed on September 27, 2005. However, the Company's expected cost of gas for October 2005 has increased significantly. As specified on Leaf 78.1 of the Gas Tariff, a new statement may be filed on one day's notice to become effective not more than five days after the effective date of the initial statement if the replacement of cost estimates in the initial statement with actual figures results in a change in the average cost of gas of more than five percent.
