The purpose of this filing is to have the Company’s tariff comply with the Commission’s Order dated October 31, 2001 in the aforementioned case. The Order revised the number of days of fuel inventory requirement that power generators must have to withstand interruptions of service. This requirement is now for five days rather than three days.
