Transportation Rates for Distributed Generation Technologies

Dear Acting Secretary Brilling:

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("Distribution" or the "Company") submits the following amendment to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 8 - GAS:

### Supplement No. 11

The proposed revision is issued as of today for an effective date of November 21, 2003. The Company requests that the Supplement be given "short notice" effective November 1, 2003 in order to go into effect simultaneously with the tariff leaves originally filed on July 23, 2003.

#### **Explanation of Filing**

Distribution submitted tariff amendments proposing to implement its distributed generation (DG) rates provided under Service Classification No. 23. These rates institute firm delivery service for commercial and industrial DG customers, as required in the Commission's *Order Providing For Distributed Generation Gas Service Classifications* issued on April 24, 2003. On October 3, 2003, Distribution filed an amendment postponing the filing until December 1, 2003. The sole purpose of this filing is to further postpone the proposed tariff amendments until January 1, 2004 to comply with Staff's request.
