Effective: October 1, 2005

The Order required that the utilities file tariff amendments and/or statements on not less than one day's notice to become effective October 1, 2005, incorporating the revisions described in the Order.

The Order establishes a 2006 RPS collection level for NYSEG of \$3,041,702. The surcharge amount for the period October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006 will be based on NYSEG's 2006 designated annual collection level and results in a \$0.00021 per kWh RPS surcharge. The RPS surcharge will be a volumetric (kWh) charge added to each energy charge on the delivery portion of customer bills¹ to all retail customers that pay the System Benefits Charge (SBC).

Any over- or under-collections will be trued up on an annual basis. NYSEG will file annually to increase the RPS charge based on the annual collection level and the Order.

Per Ordering Clause 7 of the Order, the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the changes proposed by this filing are waived.
