National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) submits the following amendment to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 8 - GAS:

Supplement No. 14

The proposed revision is issued as of today for an effective date of September 30, 2004. The Company requests that the Supplement be given “short notice” in order to go into effect simultaneously with the tariff leaves originally filed on June 2, 2004.

Explanation of Filing

Distribution submitted tariff amendments proposing to modify Distribution’s tariff in conformance with the terms and provisions of the Company’s current rate plan, approved by the Commission in an order issued in Case 00-G-1858 on September 18, 2003. Case 00-G-1858, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation, Order Establishing Rate and Restructuring Plans. The revised tariff sheets removed tariff language relating to the Competitive Backout Credit and the Low Income Residential Assistance Service. The sole purpose of this filing is to cancel the proposed tariff amendments effective September 30, 2004 to comply with the Commission’s *Order Canceling Rate Schedule Amendments and Continuing Low income and Competitive Market Programs* issued and effective September 28, 2004.
