Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or "the Company") is filing today with the Public Service Commission ("the Commission") Supplement No. 22 to the Company's Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the "Gas Tariff").

The supplement filed electronically today is to cancel previously filed tariff leaves.

## Reason for Proposed Tariff Modifications

On July 15, 2004 and August 20, 2004 ("July and August 2004 Filings"), the Company filed with the Commission changes to its Gas Tariff to include a new supplementary application form for service to customers with gas-fired distributed generation facilities applying for Rider H. By letter dated September 8, 2004, in Supplement No. 20, the effective date of the proposed tariff leaves was postponed from September 23, 2004 to October 22, 2004. By letter dated September 24, 2004, the Company filed with the Commission changes to its Gas Tariff at the request of Commission Staff to remove the Rider H application form from its Gas Tariff and to include the form instead in its Gas Transportation Operating Procedure ("GTOP").

At Staff's request, the Company is now withdrawing the July 15, 2004, August 20, 2004 and September 24, 2004 filings. Pursuant to consultation with Staff, a form for service to customers with gas-fired distributed generation facilities applying for Rider H

will be provided by the Company pursuant to the Gas Tariff, but will not be included as part of the Gas Tariff or its GTOP.

Accordingly, the Company files today Supplement No. 22 canceling the tariff leaves filed by the Company on July 15, 2004, August 20, 2004 and September 24, 2004.

The Company respectfully requests that Supplement No. 22 be allowed to go into effect on short notice on November 1, 2004, and that the requirement of newspaper publication be waived.
