Purpose of the Filing

The purpose of this filing is to set forth the enrollment period rules and procedures to be effective October 1, 2004 through December 30, 2004, as well as grace period rules and procedures effective January 1, 2005 through April 29, 2005. The tariffs also reflect rules and procedures for changing rate options during the remaining three months of the first commodity period (October 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004) and during the second two-year commodity period of January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2006.

Newspaper Publication

NYSEG requests that the requirement of Section 66 (12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1 as to newspaper publication be waived. All customers are being informed of the enrollment options through our outreach efforts and will receive direct notice of the commodity option choices through dissemination of enrollment kits and other communication vehicles as fully described in the Company's Outreach and Education Plan.
