The above tariff leaves are being filed pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order Adopting</u> <u>Revised Uniform Business Practices</u>, Issued November 21, 2003, in Case 98-M-1343 (the "November Order"), and <u>Order Granting Extensions and Denying Petitions in Part</u>, in Cases 98-M-1343, 99-M-0631, 03-M-0117 (the "Extension Order") issued December 19, 2003. Today's filing creates an Addendum within NYSEG's tariff, PSC No. 120 – Electricity, entitled UBP Addendum 1, which contains the PSC's January 2004 Uniform Business Practices ("UBPs"). The UBP Addendum is being filed in compliance with Ordering Clause 2 of the November Order and Ordering Clause 2 of the Extension Order, to tariff the Commission's revised UBP rules. NYSEG has also removed tariff provisions which were inconsistent, redundant or superseded by the contents of the UBP Addendum. NYSEG's proposed revised tariffs, together with the UBP Addendum, incorporate the PSC's Uniform Business Practices into the Company's general retail access program tariffs.

In addition, according to the Commission's <u>Order on Petitions for Rehearing and</u> <u>Clarification</u>, issued December 5, 2003, in Cases 98-M-1343, 99-M-0631, 03-M-0117 (the "December 5th Order"), NYSEG has modified its tariff provisions to further reflect Chapter 686 of the Laws of 2002. Tariff changes filed today include revised rules for ESCO-initiated termination of commodity service to customers receiving a consolidated bill. In compliance with Ordering Clause 3 of the Extension Order and Ordering Clause 1 of the December 5th Order, NYSEG is filing a revised operating procedure associated with an ESCO request for NYSEG to calculate the amount a customer would have paid if the entire utility service has been obtained from NYSEG (See Appendix A).

According to Ordering Clause No. 3 of the November Order, the requirement of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments has been waived.
