The purpose of this filing is to request to further postpone the filing presently before the Commission in the above case number. This filing was submitted to the Commission on December 20, 2002 with an effective date of March 24, 2003, and subsequently postponed to September 27, 2003 and March 27, 2004. This filing proposed to make tariff changes to Niagara Mohawk's 214 Outdoor Lighting Tariff, specifically in regards to street light billing accuracy.

Upon review by Staff of the Public Service Commission and Staff of Niagara Mohawk it has been decided that this filing should be further postponed for an additional one year, to March 27, 2005 to incorporate the objectives of Phase 2 of the Street Lighting Proceeding.
