Further Revisions

Dear Secretary Brilling:

On December 30, 2005, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("Distribution" or the "Company") filed revisions proposing to amend the Company's tariff, P.S.C. No. 8 – GAS, for the reasons stated in the transmittal letter that accompanies the filing. On January 9, 2006, the Company held a teleconference for interested stakeholders to explain the filing, answer questions and provide an opportunity for comment. As a result of the feedback received from the teleconference, the Company is submitting the following further revisions to the filing:

Leaf No. 97

Revision 3

The further revision is issued today for an effective date of March 16, 2006.

The further revision proposes to replace "Customers" with "entities" (plus conforming changes) on Leaf 97 in recognition of the fact that Customers may not be the entities to which Distribution will owe compensation for acquisition of gas. In most circumstances, the entities from which gas will be acquired will be Energy Service Companies ("Supplier" in Distribution's tariff). The proposed change will reconcile the affected provision under the Commission's short-term curtailment procedures with new language proposed on Leaf 94.1, included in the December 30 filing.

There are no further changes to the December 30 filing.
