This statement was originally filed on October 27, 2005. However, on that same day, the Commission issued an order in Case No. 05-G-0919¹ requiring the Company to implement a new mechanism under which firm transportation customers, rather than marketers, receive a surcharge/credit for differences between the cost of released capacity and the Company's weighted average cost of capacity. Therefore, the Monthly Gas Adjustment applicable to Service Classification No. 6 customers now includes a Capacity Release Service Adjustment.

The determination of the Capacity Release Service Adjustment effective November 1, 2005 is shown on the attached workpaper.
