Purpose of the Filing

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The purpose of today's filing is to make minor revisions to NYSEG's July 20, 2005, tariff filing ("July Tariff Filing"). The filing is made in cooperation with Department of Public Service Staff who requested the changes.

Revisions are proposed to Leaf 10 of PSC 87, Leaf 8 of PSC 88, Leaf 20 of PSC 120 and Leaf 6 of PSC 121 to add parentheses and brackets to the formula for the calculation of the Tax Surcharge Percentage applicable to customers who are subject to Gross Income Tax, MTA tax and municipal tax.

The remaining tariff leaves are filed to incorporate revisions resulting from other PSC Cases that affected these leaves subsequent to July 20, 2005.

Newspaper Publication & SAPA

In accordance with the requirement of Section 66 (12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1 as to newspaper publication, NYSEG respectfully requests waiver of any additional newspaper publication because the substance of today's filed changes was included in the Newspaper Publication of NYSEG's July 20, 2005 tariff filing. NYSEG filed proof of publication of the July 20, 2005 tariff filing by letter dated October 7, 2005.

Similarly, A State Administrative Procedure Act Notice is not enclosed because the substance of today's filing was included in the SAPA issued in association with the July 20, 2005 filing. Therefore, no additional SAPA is necessary.
