## Purpose of Filing

On July 29, 2005 and September 26, 2005, the Company filed tariff amendments containing proposals to reset competitive transition charges ("CTC"), recover a portion of the deferral balance associated with years five and six of the ten year Rate Plan, and implement and expand the Low Income Rate Discount Program. On December 27, 2005 the above Order was issued by the Commission approving the Company's proposals, with modifications as contained in this Order.

Ordering Clause No. 8 of this Order directed the Company to file a tariff supplement, on not less than one day's notice, to become effective January 1, 2006 canceling the amendments listed in the Appendix of this Order and to file tariff revisions in accordance with the discussion in the body of this Order to become effective on not less than one day's notice on January 1, 2006.
