Effective: December 30, 2005

This Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge (CAC) is being filed per Rule No. 29—Delivery Charge Adjustment (DCA). Specifically, Rule No. 29.2 describes the calculation of the CAC which adjusts the Delivery Charge Adjustment prices for deviations between actual costs of unhedged energy and capacity for purchased power and Electricity Supply Service (ESS) revenues collected from customers through their service bills.

Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge No. 51 is effective December 30, 2005 for batch billings and January 1, 2006 for calendar month billings.
