In compliance with the Public Service Commission's Order Establishing Rate Plan in Case 09-G-0718 - Appendix V to the Joint Proposal, Rochester Gas & Electric Corporation ("RG&E") has established a Gas Reliability Surcharge effective April 1, 2011, applicable to customers taking service from ESCOs under Service Classifications No. 5, 7a and 9. RG&E has included this surcharge in the Small Transportation Service Rate Adjustment Statement.

These rates will continue in effect until there are changes in the cost of gas that require modifications.
