Dear Secretary Brilling:

The Green Island Power Authority (GIPA) herewith submits for filing proposed revisions to GIPA's P.S.C. No. 1- Electricity, "Leaf No. 9 - Charges" to implement changes to "A. RECONNECTION CHARGE" and "B. INSUFFICIENT FUNDS CHECK CHARGE". The purpose of these revisions is to recover the increased actual costs from those ratepayers responsible for such costs.

<u>Reconnection Charge</u>: The current after-hours reconnection charge is the same as the normal working hours charge of \$25.00, which does not reflect the overtime costs of dispatching a distribution lineman during off hours. As such, these additional costs are being borne by the system's other ratepayers rather than those who are responsible for such costs. It is proposed that after-hours charge be increased from \$25.00 to \$50.00 in order to provide for the appropriate recovery of such costs.

<u>Insufficient Funds Check Charge</u>: The current tariff charge for customers' checks returned due to insufficient funds is \$10.00. The insufficient funds fee charged by our bank has increased to \$20.00 per check, resulting in a shortfall of \$10.00 on each check returned. It is proposed to increase the insufficient funds charge to \$20.00 to recover the fee imposed on GIPA.

GIPA proposes that these changes in Leaf 9 take effect on September 1, 2010, and respectfully request that the Public Service Commission approve the tariff leaf provided herein. A hard copy of this letter and the affected leaf is also being transmitted by mail. Please advise the undersigned of any questions you may have regarding this filing.
