Purpose of the Filing

The purpose of this filing is to revise Rule No. 53 – Standardized Interconnection Requirements and Application Process for New Distributed Generators 2MW or Less Connected in Parallel to Utility Distribution Systems in PSC No. 220 Electricity in compliance with the above order. Ordering Clause No. 3 directed the Company to file tariff amendments to the Company's tariff that comply with the revised Standard Interconnection Requirements (SIR) as they relate to the micro-combined heat and power and fuel cell electric generating systems.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 4 of this order, the requirements of §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication are waived for this filing.
