Effective: April 1, 2010.

Pursuant to the November and January Orders, the Company is filing revisions to its statements to collect additional revenue through the existing System Benefits Charge ("SBC") for gas customers.

The November and January Orders approved the implementation of gas energy efficiency programs to be administered by NYSERDA. The November Order identified additional collections required for each utility for the period April 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 in Table 4 of Appendix 2 and the January Order identified additional collections for each utility for the period April 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 in

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Table 8 of Appendix 3. The surcharge will be effective on April 1, 2010, and will apply to customer usage on and after that date.

Per Ordering Clause No. 12 of the November Order and Ordering Clause 9 of the January Order, the requirements of Section 66(12) (b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication of the changes proposed by this filing is waived.
