The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (“the Company”) hereby submits the following supplement to become effective February 1, 2010.

Supplement No. 56
To Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 12-GAS.

The purpose of this filing is to cancel tariff leaves filed on July 14, 2008 to remove the 2.2% deadband from the Company’s weather normalization adjustment from all firm service classifications. On December 22, 2009, the Commission issued its “Order Concerning Proposed Revenue Decoupling Mechanism” approving a revenue decoupling mechanism that will apply to firm residential heating customers only.

Permission is requested for a waiver from the Commission’s regulations governing newspaper publication of the enclosed tariff provisions.
