Dear Commissioners:

The amended tariff leaves set forth below are filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or the "Company") on October 30, 2009 to become effective November 1, 2009 in compliance with the Commission Order in Case 08-E-0751 issued and effective September 22, 2009.

In compliance with Ordering Clause No. 5 of the aforementioned Order, the leaves listed above were revised to reflect the increase in the power factor, effective May 1, 2010, that must be achieved by customers currently subject to the reactive demand provisions under SC Nos. 3 and 13 in order to avoid charges under this provision and to extend reactive provisions, effective October 1, 2011, to SC No. 2 customers whose demand in any two of the previous twelve months is 500 kW or larger. This extension to SC No. 2 reflects a request by the Company, made under separate cover to the Secretary today, to delay the implementation of reactive demand provisions for SC No. 2 customers whose demand in any two of the previous twelve months is 1000 kW or larger from May 1, 2010 to October 1, 2011.

The reactive demand rate reflected in this filing is the rate approved by the Commission in its June 22, 2009 order in Case 08-E-0887.

As directed in Ordering Clause No. 10 of the Commission's September 22, 2009 Order in this Case, the requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication have been waived. Also, as directed by Ordering Clause No. 10, affected customers were notified by letter dated October 21, 2009.
