Purpose of Filing

The purpose of this filing is to make minor conforming modifications to the current PSC No. 214 Electricity Street Lighting tariff. These modifications propose a consistent format for all information and pricing within each service classification of PSC No. 214. The Company believes that this consistent format will provide customers, as well as Company personnel, a more uniform presentation of the existing information contained in each service classification.

Along with these conforming modifications, additional changes have been made to each service classification. These changes include:

- the elimination of out of date facilities, bill codes and applicable language;
- the establishment of a tiered facility classification designation for the purpose of managing a process to transition lighting facilities, materials or technology through their life cycle;
- the inclusion of facility categories to coincide with the applicable tracking of assets and financial property records;
- the inclusion of existing, in-service “non-standard” facilities not presently illustrated in the current tariff;
- the inclusion of customer requested options and alternatives to the normal conduct of business; and
- a service charge schedule to be utilized for customer requested work items.

The proposed changes have no impact on the products, services and business applications currently in practice. As stated above, these changes are intended merely to update and clarify the tariff for all users. This filing does not alter presently applied rates or charges and therefore will have no adverse revenue or customer impacts from what is presently transacted in the normal course of business.
