> RE: CASE 06-G-1186 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a KeySpan Energy Delivery Long Island – Transportation and Balancing Collaborative

Dear Secretary Brilling:

In accordance with the Public Service Commission of the State of New York's ("Commission") "Order Approving Transportation and Balancing Collaborative Report Recommendations with Modifications" dated June 23, 2009 ("June 23rd Order"), The KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a KeySpan Energy Delivery Long Island ("KEDLI" or "the Company") hereby submits one copy of the revised tariff leaves listed in Appendix A issued by KEDLI to its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 1 on July 31, 2009 to become effective on a temporary basis on August 1, 2008. The purpose of the filing is to comply with Ordering Paragraph No. 1 contained in the June 23 Order.

Specifically, the Company is modifying its tariff to: 1) ensure its gas delivery nomination procedures are consistent with FERC requirements; 2) modify the city gate balancing and cash out prices of the monthly balanced services; 3) modify the daily cash out prices of the daily balanced services; and 4) implement new load factor differentiated daily swing service monthly demand charge for the monthly balanced services.

In addition, the Company is filing new statements for sellers and transportation customers taking service under the Company's monthly and daily balanced transportation services that will list all new rates and charges associated with this Order as well as existing rates and charges. The Company is also eliminating incorrect references to unaccounted-for-gas percentages.

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Under the June 23 Order, the Company is directed to offer Monthly Balancing Service to interruptible and temperature controlled (TC) customers that currently take service under the Company's Existing Daily Balancing Program until such time that the Company implements a New Daily Balancing Program. However, the Company is unable able to offer these customers a Monthly Balancing Service option by August 1, 2009 because its existing customer billing and data warehouse information systems do not support Monthly Balancing. The Company estimates that it will have the necessary systems in place to implement Monthly Balancing by June 1, 2010.
