Dear Secretary Brilling:

Enclosed for filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") is a revised schedule leaf issued by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") that makes a change to its Schedule for Steam Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – Steam, applicable to its customers in the Borough of Manhattan, New York City.

The Company's schedule leaf, identified below, has an effective date of July 1, 2009:

P.S.C. No. 4 - Steam

Leaf No. 42, Revision 2

The Company is also filing the following statement, which has an effective date of July 1, 2009:

Statement of Temporary State Assessment Surcharge, TSAS – Statement No. 1 to P.S.C. No. 4 – Steam

Reason for Filing

This filing is being made pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order Implementing Temporary State Assessment</u> (the "Order"), issued June 19, 2009, in Case 09-M-0311, "Implementation of Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2009 Establishing a Temporary Annual Assessment Pursuant to Public Service Law §18-a (6)." Pursuant to the Order, any Public Service Law §18-a amounts required to be collected above the amount in base rates for each State Fiscal Year (April through March) commencing Fiscal Year 2009-2010 are to be collected through a surcharge over 12 months (July through June) and shall include an adjustment for uncollectible expenses and working capital costs. Public Service Law §18-a amounts to be recovered are to be

reconciled with actual amounts recovered, and any difference is to be reflected in a subsequent annual surcharge.

Tariff Change

The tariff leaf filed herewith adds a new provision to General Information Section 5 entitled, "Temporary State Assessment Surcharge." The surcharge amount for each State Fiscal Year and the associated allocation to each customer class is based on class revenues inclusive of fuel adjustments and gross receipts taxes.

Surcharge amounts will be collected from steam Service Classifications ("SC"s) 1, 2, and 3 per Mlb; from SCs 4 per Mlb/hour of Contract Demand; and from SC 5 per unit in effect under the customer's otherwise applicable SC.

The Statement filed herewith reflects the unit amounts to be collected per SC commencing July 1, 2009.

Conclusion

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the tariff amendment and Statement are being filed within ten business days of that Order's issuance, to become effective on July 1, 2009. (As directed by Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, future tariff statements are to be filed on 15 days' notice.) Pursuant to Ordering Clause 3 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
