## **Description of Tariff Revisions**

#### Credit Methodologies

The Company is revising its tariffs to reflect the dollar method for crediting demand-billed customers. The dollar method requires the Company to convert kilowatt-hours to a dollar value using the applicable tariff per kilowatt-hour rate and applying the credit to the current utility bill. If the dollar value of the kilowatt-hours exceeds the current utility bill, any remaining dollars are converted back to kilowatt-hours and carried forward to the next billing period.

## **Newspaper Publication**

In accordance with Ordering Paragraph 3, the requirement of § 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication is waived.
