In accordance with the Order issued and effective June 17, 2010 in Case 09-G-0859, the Company is returning to Service Class No. 1 and 5 customers the refunds that the Company has received to date from Tennessee Gas Pipeline. As approved in the Order, customers will receive the refund on an expedited three month schedule.

In accordance with the Order Concerning Reconciliation of Gas Costs, issued and effective December 21, 2010 in Case 10-G-0467, RG&E has incorporated the surcharge for the January 1, 2010 to December 31, 2010 time period.

In accordance with the Order Adopting Provisions of Joint Proposals with Conditions, issued and effective May 20, 2004 in Case 03-G-0766, RG&E has updated the Factor of Adjustment.

These rates will continue in effect until there are changes in the cost of gas that require modifications.
