Effective January 10, 2011.

The above tariff addenda are being filed pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order Implementing Chapter 416 of the Laws of 2010</u>, issued and effective December 17, 2010 (the "Order").

Ordering Clause 3 of the Order directs utilities to file revised Uniform Business Practices ("UBP") Addenda. The revisions that were approved in Ordering Clause 1 update the UBP Addenda in accordance with the amendments to the general business law (GBL) ¹.

The addition of section §349-d sets forth requirements that energy service companies (ESCO) must comply with when marketing energy services, defined as natural gas or electricity, to residential customers and/or through door-to-door sales and required the Commission to develop an ESCO Consumers Bill of Rights (ECBR).

Accordingly, revised electric and gas UBP addenda reflecting the approved revisions to the UBP are filed herein.

Requirements of Public Service Law Section 66 (12) (b) as to newspaper publication of the tariff revisions are waived pursuant to Ordering Clause 4 of the Order.
