National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) submits the following amendment to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 8 - GAS:

Leaf No. 148.9 Revision 8

The proposed revision is issued as of today for an effective date of December 1, 2010. The Company requests that the amendment be given “short notice” in order to go into effect on December 1, 2010 which will coincide with the monthly billing statements that are filed by the Company to be effective during the month of December 2010. Attached is a workpaper that calculates the proposed rate.

The instant filing is a further revision in compliance with the Commission’s order dated November 22, 2010 in the above referenced case that changes the billing rate, modifies and extends the Company’s Conservation Incentive Program (“CIP”) through November 2011.

Customers are being notified of changes to the CIP in an extensive outreach and education campaign. The change to the funding allowance implemented through this filing, on its own, has no material effect on customer service.
