Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or the "Company") hereby submits the proposed tariff amendments listed below to become effective February 1, 2011.

P.S.C. No. 12 - Gas

4th Revised Leaf No. 117.1 Original Leaf No. 117.2

The purpose of these amendments is to revise the commodity price points and weightings for the Winter Bundled Sales (WBS) service option provided under the Company's Retail Access Program to reflect changes to pipeline capacity that the Company has under contract and utilizes for WBS as discussed more fully below.

WBS, a virtual storage program, was first provided to retail suppliers during the period November 2007 through March 2008 pursuant to the Commission's Order in Case 05-G-0935. The current commodity price points for WBS, which have remained unchanged since the inception of WBS, are based on the Canadian capacity/supply that the Company has under contract and which is assumed to be used for storage injections during the period April through October. Based on known capacity changes, the Company proposes to revise the WBS commodity price points and weightings as follows:

The Company is proposing an effective date of February 1, 2011, which is approximately 40 days prior to the last date that retail suppliers can elect WBS for the November 2011 – March 2012 winter season.

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These revisions were previously discussed with Staff of the Department of Public Service (Staff) and were reviewed with Staff and retail suppliers approved to provide service in the Company's franchise area during a collaborative teleconference on August 18, 2010. In addition, the Company will be providing, via e-mail, a copy of this filing to the aforementioned retail suppliers. Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that the publication requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication be waived.
