The purpose of this filing is to cancel the tariff amendments submitted to the Commission on
April 1, 2010 proposing Rule No. 59 – Smart Program Adjustment Surcharge which was issued in
compliance with the Commission's July 27, 2009 Order Authorizing Recovery of Costs Associated
with Stimulus Projects. On October 19, 2010, the Public Service Commission issued its *Order
Establishing Recovery Mechanisms for Smart Grid Projects* and directed the listed utilities to file
supplements, on not less than one day's notice, to be effective on November 1, 2010, canceling their
respective tariff amendments.

Also, per Ordering Clause No. 4 of this Order, waiver of the requirements of §66(12) of the
Public Service Law as to newspaper publication is granted for this filing.
