The amended tariff leaf set forth below is filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") on November 1, 2010 to become effective on December 1, 2010.

P.S.C. No. 15 – Electricity

4th Revised Leaf No. 39

The purpose of this filing is to revise the contribution required from an applicant in instances where the Company, during its supply configuration design process, determines that three-phase service is required to meet the anticipated electrical needs of an applicant's proposed residential subdivision in order to discharge the Company's obligation to provide safe, adequate and reliable service.

This filing was initially made with the Commission on March 25, 2010 to be effective on July 1, 2010. Since the initial filing, the effective date was postponed in order to allow for time for further review by Staff. Subsequent to discussion with Staff regarding their review, Central Hudson Gas & Electric hereby files a revised tariff leaf to incorporate a rate to be applied per trench foot for the incremental cost of three-phase wire. The incremental cost of appurtenant facilities will be determined specific to each job.
