Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or the "Company") hereby submits the proposed tariff amendment listed below to become effective August 14, 2010.

P.S.C. No. 15 - Electricity

13th Revised Leaf No. 184.2.1

Pursuant to Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Commissions' February 11, 2010 Order in this Case, the Company filed on March 9, 2010 tariff leaves to effectuate the expansion of the Company's mandatory Hourly Pricing Program to all S.C. No. 2 customers with demands exceeding 500 kW in any two of the previous twelve months. After further consultations with PSC Staff it has been determined that in order for the Company to move forward with HPP expansion and meet its proposed October 1, 2010 deadline for meter installations, it must offer customers the option to have the Company provide the required telecommunications to the meter through the use of cell meters. The Company is filing the tariff leaf listed above to effectuate the use of cell meters with Company provided communications. The Company proposes to recover the cost of the cellular service from customers choosing this option through an adder to the existing incremental monthly charge.

As directed in Ordering Clause No. 3 of the aforementioned Order, the requirements of 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication have been waived.
