Re: Forest Park Water Company, Inc. - Application to increase the maximum balance in the company's escrow account as well as the surcharges to fund and replenish the account.

Dear Secretary Brillling:

Forest Park Water Company, Inc. (the company) provides metered water service to about 875 customers in 12 separate and non-contiguous water systems. No fire protection service is provided.

The enclosed Escrow Account Statement No. 4 to Tariff Schedule P.S.C. No. 2—Water, filed by the company, is transmitted electronically for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission of the State of New York.

Effective date: October 1, 2010

The company is being faced with the need to replace a portion of the distribution system at one of its water systems the cost of which is expected to exceed the maximum balance of \$50,000 that it is authorized to keep in its current escrow account. Accordingly, the company is requesting to be allowed to increase the maximum balance to \$100,000. In order to fund this as soon as possible so that the needed work can be done, the company is requesting to be allowed to increase the quarterly surcharge from \$10 per customer to \$30. Since the company expects other expenditures to come up in the future, the company is also requesting to be allowed to raise the surcharge it can bill its customers to replenish the account once funds have been used from \$10 to \$50 per customer per quarter. This would enable the company to have funds on hand to do most needed work.

By this letter, it is requested that the Staff of the Water Rates Section file the attached escrow account statement as well as any other filings required by the Commission electronically.

Forest Park Water Company, Inc. also requests waiver of newspaper publication since it plans to individually notify its customers of the tariff filing.
