Dear Acting Secretary Cohen:

By letter dated October 12, 2012, Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the “Company”) filed with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) an amendment to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – Electricity to become effective February 1, 2013 in compliance with the Commission’s Notice Establishing Filing Requirements, issued September 7, 2012 in Case No. 12-E-0398. At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company filed Supplement No. 1 on December 14, 2012, postponing the effective date of the tariff amendment to March 1, 2013.

Commission Staff has requested a further postponement of the effective date of the proposed tariff amendment to April 1, 2013, to allow time for further review of the proposed changes.

The Company accordingly files Supplement No. 2 to postpone to April 1, 2013, the effective date of the tariff amendment included in its October 12, 2012 filing. Supplement No. 2 is issued January 29, 2013, with an effective date of March 1, 2013. The Company requests that the requirements for newspaper publication be waived.
