Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge Statement No. 39 To P.S.C. 220 Electricity

Effective: May 31, 2012

This Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge (CAC) is being filed per Rule No. 29 – Delivery Charge Adjustment (DCA). Specifically, Rule No. 29.2 describes the calculation of the CAC which adjusts the Delivery Charge Adjustment prices for deviations between actual costs of unhedged energy and capacity for purchased power and Electricity Supply Service (ESS) revenues collected from customers through their service bills. Rule 29 expired effective February 29, 2012. However, the CAC continued to be billed until the end of May 2012 to credit the remaining balance in the deferral account, in accordance with the aggregate rate caps in Rule 29.2.10.

Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge No. 39 is effective May 31, 2012 for batch billings and June 1, 2012 for calendar month billings. It is a supplementary rate statement filed for the purpose of formalizing the closure of the Rule 29 CAC mechanism. The effective rates are zero.
