The attached leaf, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, d/b/a National Grid ("Company"), is being transmitted for filing in compliance with the order issued September 19, 2011 ("September 19 Order") in the above case number.

First Revised Leaf No. 194.2

To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity

Effective: July 1, 2012

The referenced leaf is being filed in compliance with the September 19 Order which directed the listed utilities to file tariff amendments implementing discounted rates for delivery of Recharge New York ("RNY") power allocations to participants deemed eligible by the New York Power Authority to receive such allocations. Original Leaf No. 194.2 was filed October 31, 2012 and was approved by the Commission to become effective on a temporary basis on November 1, 2011.

On further consideration, the Company proposes to revise the referenced leaf, specifically Rule No. 34.6.2.5, to reduce the notice period for commencement of RNY service from 60 days to 30 days. This revision is requested to become effective on thirty days notice, on July 1, 2012, to be consistent with the effective date of the RNY program.

Per Ordering Clause No. 5 of the September 19 Order, the Company requests the requirements of newspaper publication under Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law be waived for this filing. Please advise the undersigned of any action taken regarding this filing.
