This Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge (CAC) is being filed per Rule No. 29 Delivery Charge Adjustment (DCA). Specifically, Rule No. 29.2 describes the calculation of the CAC which adjusts the Delivery Charge Adjustment prices for deviations between actual costs of unhedged energy and capacity for purchased power and Electricity Supply Service (ESS) revenues collected from customers through their service bills. Rule 29 expired effective February 29, 2012. However, the CAC shall continue to be billed until the end of May 2012 in order to credit the remaining balance in the deferral account in accordance with the aggregate rate caps in Rule 29.2.10. The remaining balance represents deferred reconciliation amounts and carrying charges associated with cost months prior to January 2012.

Statement of Commodity Adjustment Charge No. 38 is effective Aprl 30, 2012 for batch billings and May 1, 2012 for calendar month billings.

Please note that this statement lists the final reconciliation rates. Next month, a supplementary rate statement will be filed that formalizes and clarifies the closing of the CAC with close-out rates of zero.
