On March 16, 2012, the Commission issued its order in the above case number approving the Company's tariff filing which proposed revisions incorporating amendments to PSL §66-J which extended net metering to non-residential customers that own, lease or operate fuel cell generating equipment with a total rated capacity of not more than 1.5 MW. These amendments also included net metering to both residential and non-residential customers that own or operate micro-hydro generating equipment with a rated capacity of not more than 25 kW and 2MW, respectively.

Ordering Clause No. 3 directed the utilities to comply with the revised Standard Interconnection Requirements ("SIR") and file revised SIR addenda to the tariffs on not less than three day's notice to become effective April 1, 2012. Rule No. 53 – Standardized Interconnection Requirements and Application Process for New Distributed Generators – 2MW or Less Connected in Parallel to Utility Distribution Systems and Form K – Standardized Contract for Interconnection of New Distributed Generation Units with Capacity of 2MW or Less Connected in Parallel With Utility Distribution Systems have been updated verbatim from the revised SIR.

Per Ordering Clause No. 2 of this Order, waiver of the requirements of 16 NYCRR §720-8 of the Commission's regulations as to newspaper publication is granted for this filing.
