Re: Case 08-E-0539, New Electricity Rate Schedule, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity

Dear Secretary Brillling:

On July 15, 2011, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”), proposing a new electricity rate schedule, Schedule for Electricity, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, to supersede P.S.C. No. 9 – Electricity and P.S.C. No. 2 – Retail Access.¹ P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity is applicable to the Company’s customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester. P.S.C. No. 10 will become effective on February 20, 2012, pursuant to the Commission’s Order issued and effective February 16, 2012, regarding “Tariff filings by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. to replace its electric tariff schedules with electronic tariff schedules compatible with the Commission’s Electronic Tariff System” (the “Order”).

As directed by the Order, the Company is filing conforming changes, to become effective on February 20, 2012. The Company is also filing a housekeeping change to become effective on the same date. The tariff leaves, Statements, and Addendum are identified in Appendix A. The changes are described below.

Changes

The Company has made conforming changes to P.S.C. No. 10 to reflect tariff changes that were made to P.S.C. No. 9 – Electricity and P.S.C. No. 2 – Retail Access and approved by the Commission after PSC No. 10 was issued.² The tariff changes have been reflected in P.S.C. No. 10, as follows:

¹ The Company was required to convert its electric tariffs to an electronic format using the Department of Public Service Electronic Tariff System, pursuant to the Commission’s Order Setting Electric Rates, issued April 24, 2009, in Case 08-E-0539 and the Joint Proposal (page 43) that was adopted by the Commission’s Order Establishing Three-year Electric Rate Plan, issued March 26, 2010, in Case 09-E-0428. As specified in the Joint Proposal, the Company was required to complete the conversion prior to the end of Rate Year 2, which ends March 31, 2012.

² Other tariff filings were made to P.S.C. No. 9 after P.S.C. No. 10 was issued and are not yet effective. Conforming

Also, because several places in P.S.C. No. 10 referred to November 1, 2011, the effective date originally proposed for PSC No. 10, the Company has modified Leaf Nos. 5, 170, 346, 407, 433, 447, 481, and 494 to reflect the change in the Schedule's effective date to February 20, 2012. The Company has also corrected a typographical error that appeared in the header of several tariff leaves in the Service Classifications section of the tariff.

The Company is filing Statements to P.S.C. No. 10 that contain the monetary amounts that were formerly filed in P.S.C. No. 9 – Electricity and P.S.C. No. 2 – Retail Access. The Statement types are as follows: MAC, MSC-CAP, MSC ADJ, MAC ADJ, MFC, GRT, SBC, RPS, RDM, PSL, ACUF, ICAP, TEL, and RAC.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 2, the leaves, statements, and addendum specified in Appendix A are issued on not less than one day's notice, to become effective on February 20, 2012. As directed by Ordering Clause 3, the Commission has waived newspaper publication of these changes.
