Fifth Revised Leaf No. 198

To PSC No. 220 Electricity

Effective: April 1, 2012

On December 21, 2011, in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the above order the utilities were directed to file tariffs providing for the net metering of micro-hydroelectric and fuel cell generating facilities in accordance with the discussions in the body of this order by December 21, 2011 to become effective on April 1, 2012.

The above leaf was included in this compliance filing of December 21, 2011 and is being resubmitted for a minor housekeeping revision. Specifically, Rule No. 36.4 has been revised to point to Rule No. 53 – Standardized Interconnection Requirements and Application Process for New Distributed Generators 2 MW or Less Connected in Parallel to Utility Distribution Systems for transformer costs.

This leaf is requested to be effective April 1, 2012, the effective date of the leaves presently before the Commission in this case number.

Waiver of the requirements of 16 NYCRR §720-8 of the Commission’s regulations as to newspaper publication is requested for this filing. Customer-Generators will be informed of these changes by the Company when they apply for remote net metering.
