Effective: March 1, 2012

On December 8, 2011, the Companies proposed revisions to its tariffs to reflect the conversion from power purchase contracts to revenue sharing agreements. After further discussion with Department of Public Service Staff, the Companies are proposing an additional tariff revision to specify the application of carrying charges at the other customer deposit rate in effect at the time payments are refunded to customers through the Transition Charge.

The Companies reiterate its request that the requirement of § 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication be waived because the benefits from the RSA reflect a transaction that is not identified separately on a customer's bill and will not adversely affect the calculation of the Transition Charge.
