This filing is in compliance with the Commission's Summary of Recommendation issued on
December 20, 2011 approving the Company's request, with modification, for a three-year
extension to continue to accept applications for its Area Development Rate (ADR) and Business
Incentive Rate (BIR) through December 31, 2014. These leaves contain the revisions to include
a requirement for any new customers in existing buildings to have an energy efficiency audit
performed in order to qualify for either ADR or BIR. The audit must be performed within six
months of applying for the program and must be performed by either New York State Energy
Research Development Authority (NYSERDA); some other governmental authority that
administers energy efficiency programs; an independent third party; or Customer personnel
capable of conducting a comparable audit.
