To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity

Effective: January 1, 2012

On September 20, 2011 the Company submitted a filing to amend P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity, Service Classification No. 4 –Untransformed Service to Certain Customers Taking Power From Projects of the New York Power Authority (“NYPA) to allow for the delivery of NYPA Preservation Power (“PP”). PP is a new NYPA program. Customers with a PP allocation will pay standard tariff rates for delivery of PP but are exempt from the Competitive Transition Charge (“CTC”), Renewable Portfolio Surcharge (“RPS”), and System Benefit Charge (“SBC”).

After further review of this filing, it was decided by Staff of the Public Service Commission that further revisions were needed for this filing to which the Company agreed. Accordingly, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission accept these revised tariff sheets for filing.

Waiver is respectfully requested of the requirements of newspaper publication as required by the Commission’s regulations at 16 NYCRR Section 720-8, since impacted Customers will be notified of these changes.

Please advise the undersigned of any action taken regarding this filing.
