Effective: January 1, 2012

On March 10, 2011 and June 21, 2011, the Company submitted proposed tariff modifications to its commodity rate mechanisms pursuant to the Commission’s Order establishing Rates for Electric Service issued on January 24, 2011. On July 15, 2011, the PSC issued its order approving the Company’s proposed tariff leaves to become effective January 1, 2012.

Ordering Clause No. 1 directed that the Company file further tariff revisions regarding (1) inclusion of the demand curve in the capacity cost collection formula for non-MHP customers; and (b) postponement of the commencement of the capacity tag cost collection methodology until May 1, 2012. These further revisions were directed to be filed on not less than 60 days notice to become effective January 1, 2012. The above leaves comply with this directive.

The requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) and 16NYCRR 720.8.1 regarding newspaper publication of these further revisions are waived for this filing.
