Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing with the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission") revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 - Gas.

The tariff leaf reflecting the revisions is identified below:

P.S.C. No. 9 - Gas

Leaf 182, Revision 12 Superseding Revision 11

The Company is also filing a revised Statement of System Benefits Charge (Statement No. 8) to P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas.

The tariff leaf and statement are issued September 1, 2011 to become effective on October 1, 2011

## Reason for the Filing

The Commission's <u>Order Granting Rehearing, Reaffirming Utility Shareholder Incentives For 2009</u> <u>Through 2011, And Adjusting Certain Program Targets And Budgets (the "August 2011 Order"), issued and</u> effective August 22, 2011, in the above referenced case, reduced the Company's gas System Benefits Charge ("SBC") collections by \$799,376 for the remainder of 2011. Ordering Clause 5 of the August 2011 Order directed that the Company file tariff amendments and/or statements on not less than 30 days' notice to become effective October 1, 2011, incorporating the revised collection amount. ## Summary of Proposed Changes

In compliance with the August 2011 Order, Leaf 182 Special Adjustments Section IX(16), has been amended to reflect the revised 2011 SBC collection amount. In addition the SBC on Statement No. 8 reflects a \$799,376 reduction in SBC collections during the period October 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011. This results in a reduction in the SBC from 2.3119 cents per therm to 2.0378 cents per therm, effective October 1, 2011.

## **Conclusion**

In compliance with the August 2011 Order, the Company is filing its tariff amendments on not less than 30 days' notice to become effective on October 1, 2011. As directed by Ordering Clause 5 of the August 2011 Order, the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication are waived.
