**RE: Case 09-S-0794, Steam Rate Plan, and Case 09-S-0029, Hudson Avenue --
Steam Peak Reduction Pilot Programs**

Dear Secretary Brillling:

On July 28, 2011, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission"), proposing changes to the Company's Schedule for Steam Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – Steam. The Company's filing proposed to establish Rider F - Demand Response Pilot Programs and Rider G - Customer Sited Supply Pilot Program. The Company also proposed cost and lost revenue recovery through the Special Monthly Adjustments and the cost of fuel, as applicable.

Staff of the Department of Public Service has requested that the Company postpone the effective date of the tariff leaves to November 23, 2011. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 4 to P.S.C. No. 4 – Steam.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days' notice, and has an effective date of October 19, 2011. However, since the tariff leaves were issued with an effective date of October 17, 2011, the Company requests that it be authorized to put the supplement filed today into effect on short notice, i.e., October 17, 2011.

The Company requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date of the tariff leaves.
