## Dear Secretary Brilling:

In accordance with the <u>Order Establishing Rate Plan</u>, issued and effective September 21, 2010 in the above-referenced cases, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E") hereby file the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Statements to be effective November 1, 2011.

RDM Statement No. 2 to PSC 16 Gas RDM Statement No. 2 to PSC 19 Electric RDM Statement No. 2 to PSC 87 Gas RDM Statement No. 2 to PSC 88 Gas RDM Statement No. 1 to PSC 120 Electric

The filing of service classification or sub-classification specific RDM surcharge/credit rates is in accordance with the Companies' filed tariffs and Appendix U of the Rate Plan. NYSEG and RG&E will file the annual service classification or sub-classification specific RDM surcharge/credit rates with the Commission, on not less than 30 days notice, to be effective November 1st of each year.

On September 15, 2011, RG&E submitted a Petition for Modification of RDM Revenue Targets for the SC 8 ST-Industrial and SC8 ST-Commercial service classes. In accordance with that
