This tariff filing is addressing two issues. First, the Company is proposing to amend its tariff to include "Tier 1 – Capacity Release" and "Tier 2 - Bundled Winter Sales" services as part of the Company's Mandatory Capacity Release Program in its Service Classification No. 19 Seller Transportation Aggregation Service. These services were inadvertently omitted from prior tariff filings. Second, the Company is proposing to add a defined term for "Force Majeure" to its Service Classification No. 19 - Seller Transportation Aggregation Service, consistent with the terms of KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid's Service Classification No. 8 Seller Service.

In accordance with Section 720-2.3 of the Commission's Regulations, a proposed notice of this filing suitable for use under the State Administrative Procedure Act is also enclosed.
